us. We are hoping to be at 50% by the end of February if not sooner. Every pledge is one step closer and every pledge means so much to us.

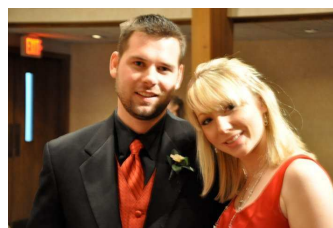
If you are supporting us, we know you are praying for us, and if you are praying, then we know that you are sharing with others about what God is doing.
