

Royal Rangers Kansas District Pow Wow 2011

Information

DATE: Sept. 16-18, 2011
PLACE: Wheat State Camp: 11177 SW 87th St. Augusta , Ks 67010
TIME: Begins 2:00PM, Friday 16th -Dismissal 2:00PM, Sunday 18th
Cost: \$50 (Chartered Outpost, by August 1st deadline – after that 55)
\$60 (Un-Chartered Outpost by August 1st deadline – after that \$65)
THEME: God's Army

SECURITY PATROL: A 24 hour security patrol will be implemented. We ask that commanders and Expedition Rangers sign up during registration to take part in this vital responsibility.

ENTERING & LEAVING CAMPGROUND: Every individual is to notify the security office when entering or exiting the campground.

CONTROL AND SUPERVISION: Outpost Commanders are to control and supervise the boys in their outpost at all times. Ensure that the "Buddy System" is in place - Every person 17 and younger must be with a buddy at all times.

KEEP CAMP CLEAN: Trash maintenance is a must to keep the camp clean and sanitary. Cooperation by all participants is necessary to ensure that trash is properly disposed of. If trash is found, the concession stand will be closed.

ALL ADULTS AND BOYS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND: Morning Devotions, Assemblies and Council Fires. Do not be late!

COUNCIL FIRE: No one is to be in the Council Fire area except when instructed to go there. Flashlights will remain off at the Council Fire Area until after Council Fire is over. If caught with a flashlight on, it will be taken from you.

VEHICLES: Do not drive vehicles off the roads. After unloading move and lock vehicles and trailers to parking areas. Look for parking signs.

RESTROOMS AND SHOWERS: Please help keep showers and restrooms clean. They are here for you to use, and nobody wants to use a dirty restroom or shower. Boys use boy's showers and men use men's showers. You can shower anytime.

FIRE SAFETY: Fires are permitted in a fire ring. Before starting fire, the sod must be gently removed, keeping in mind it must be replaced at the conclusion of Powwow. Each outpost is responsible for bringing their own fire wood and fire safety equipment.

PERMISSION FORMS: (included on "Camper Registration Form") Must have a check mark by each event that you are participating in.

BANNED ACTIVITIES & ITEMS: Do not cut trees or limbs from trees. Smoking, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, indecent literature, fireworks and firearms are not permitted at camp.

FIRST AID: The First Aid Station will be in the gym. If you need First Aid, go with an adult to the First Aid Station.

BE CONSIDERATE: Be polite, kind and thoughtful. Remain on roads and pathways, and do not take shortcuts through campsites. Leave others' personal property alone, and take care of Wheat State Camp.

CONCESSIONS: Cold drinks, snacks and candy will be sold. The Camp Commander will determine hours of operation

VISITORS: Visitors are permitted on Saturday from 10:00am to 3:00pm. Although female personnel are not permitted to attend camp, special permission may be granted for attendance at the evening council fire services by the District Commander. Appointed staff workers, invited guests and local Pastors are also permitted to attend the council fires.

PATCHES & AWARDS: Will be awarded Sunday during closing ceremony after your campsite has passed inspection by the Sanitation Officer.

Outpost Competitions & Awards

BGMC AWARD: To support our Ministry Partner BGMC (Boys and Girls Missionary Challenge) we are asking outposts to fill their "Masters Tool Box". Money raised will help fund Missions projects of the Royal Rangers and around the world. This award will be presented to the outpost bringing the largest BGMC offering to Powwow. *(Additional Master's Tool Boxes are available at no charge by calling 1-800-641-4310).* **Kansas District Royal Rangers has pledged \$500.00 towards the "Masters Tool Box".** Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place

OUTPOST STANDARD, T-SHIRT AND BOLO TIE AWARD: Bolo tie, Standard and T-shirt submissions may be computer generated, hand crafted, or be a combination of both. They will be judged on art work, representation of the theme, representation of outpost, boy's participation and level of difficulty. To qualify for these awards, submitting outposts must have enough of their submitted design (t-shirt and/or bolo) for each leader and boy in their outpost to wear at Powwow. Submissions must be turned in to Kay before noon on Saturday. Awards will be Presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place for all three competitions.

OUTPOST YELL: During free time on Saturday, we will hear yells from each outpost in Dining Hall. Will be judges on Props, boy's participation, and enthusiasm. Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Places.

CAMPFIRE STUNT: If you wish to perform a stunt, notify Kay at registration. Will be called for Fri. or Sat. evening services. Will be judged on props, boys participation, enthusiasm, audible and difficulty. Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place

BEST ENTRYWAY AWARD: Entryway will be judged on representation of the theme, representation of the outpost, participation by the boys, (at least 50% of the work must be completed by the boys), difficulty and overall appearance. Entryway may be worked on prior to Powwow, then assembled at the campsite. Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place .

CLEANEST OUTPOST CAMPSITE AWARD: Campsites will be randomly inspected throughout Powwow, and at the conclusion of Powwow. First place award only.

DISTRICT CHOICE CAMPSITE AWARD: _ See Campsite inspection form. Awards will be will be presented for 1st thru 10th Place .

MILITARY VEHICLE RACE: See Military vehicle race information sheet.

Events

PAINT BALL: Each participant will receive an arm band that they must have before you play. No mixing age groups. Discovery will not play with Adventure and Expedition Rangers. Each boy will receive only 250 paint balls when they are done. There must be two Royal Rangers leaders there at all times. Must obey rules or you will be asked to leave the course. **Must have Registration Form checked for this event.**

ROCK WALL: Just for Fun. No Awards. **Must have Registration Form checked for this event.**

MARSHMALLOW GUN: Just for Fun. Everyone that Pre-registers will get a Marshmallow Gun.

OBSTACLE Course: Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place for each age group. **Must have registration from checked for this event.**

HAND GRENADE THROW: Just for fun. No Awards.

BOMB BUILDING: Three man team. Will be timed on how fast you can build bomb. Awards 1st, 2nd, 3rd Place in each age group.

MILITARY VEHICLE RACE: Three man team. Each vehicle must race three laps and must have a different driver for each lap. See vehicle race information page.

VETERAN DISPLAY AND CEREMONY: Will have a Veteran display in the Dining Hall. We need any kind of military items (such as, Medals, Pictures, Uniforms, Gear and etc) from any member in your family that have served or is serving in any military branch. The Ceremony will be held at Saturday evening service. Need names on items so they can be returned to their owners. Kansas District Royal Rangers will not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged military items.
