What happens at camp, changes the world! 2023 was a strong year for Wheat State Retreat Center. This year we hosted 60 groups / events. Twenty-one of these were AGK groups. Fifteen of these groups were new to the WSRC guest family. From these 60 groups we had the privilege of serving 6,526 guests. That is 6,526 people having the opportunity to worship the Living God in one of our meeting spaces, build lifelong relationships while enjoying our various amenities, and the best part, having the opportunity to meet with God at our camp altars. Camp altars truly alter lives.

In 2023 we were able to tackle some much-needed maintenance projects.

- Replaced the walk-in freezer. Saved over \$30,000 by doing some research and WSRC team doing the work.
- Repaired and refinished the dining hall and tabernacle floors. We saved \$35,000 by doing some research and WSRC team doing the work.
- Rebuilt 10 RV stalls with new wiring, timbers, gravel, and turf paid for by a generous donor.
- Converted our final "camp house" into a bunk house adding 24 new beds with 3 toilets, showers, and sinks.
- 26 dead trees cut down and removed and all trees inspected and trimmed as need for safety tree trimming crew was provided and paid for by a generous donor.
- Tabernacle interior received a new coat of paint, entry foyer was wrapped in cedar and a cedar wainscot was added to the back wall thank you to all the volunteers who helped.
- New signs were installed at the entrance of the grounds signs and installation were donated.
